Cranksgiving is an alley cat race that is part bike ride, part holiday giving drive, and part scavenger hunt. Cyclists supply the bike, a bag, and about \$20 to spend on winter hats, gloves, mittens, socks and personal care items.

Summit Cycling Center gives cyclists a map and a list of items needed most by the less fortunate in our community. Cyclists select their route for the race.

Cyclists visit stores and buy at least 10 items valued at \$20 during the bike ride. Cyclists are welcome to race against the clock or ride socially by themselves or on teams. They return to Summit Cycling Center where their purchases are donated to the St. Bernard's Food Pantry.

Summit Cycling Center is hosting a celebratory free lunch with door prizes and other prizes after the ride.
